



Housing Authority of the City of Shreveport (HACS) is excited to announce 44 Emergency Housing Vouchers (EHVs) available through the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA).

Emergency Housing Vouchers (EHVs) are tenant-based rental assistance under the Housing Choice Voucher Program. Referrals for this voucher program will be given by the Continuum of Care (CoC) for HOPE Connections of Northwest Louisiana (HOPE).

Emergency Housing Vouchers (EHVs) will begin July 2021. Per the “PIH2021-15 Notice” issued by HUD to be considered for eligibility for an Emergency Housing Vouchers (EHVs), an individual or family must meet one of four eligibility categories:

- Homeless
- At risk of homelessness
- Fleeing, or attempting to flee, domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, stalking, or human trafficking
- Recently homeless and for whom providing rental assistance will prevent the family’s homelessness or having high risk of housing instability.
